- The insured simply completes the claim and authorization forms and attaches copies of any itemized bills which show the treatment or services the insured received as a result of an accident. If the claim is due to a motor vehicle accident, a copy of the accident report is needed.
- **HEALTH SCREENING/WELLNESS TEST**
If this rider is included with the policy, the insured needs to complete the Health Screening/Wellness Benefit claim form and attach medical documentation, such as a copy of the bill or medical report, which shows the test performed and the date of the test.
- **SICKNESS HOSPITAL CONFINEMENT**
If this rider is included with the policy, the insured needs to complete the claim and authorization forms and attach a copy of the hospitalization bill. If the claim is incurred during the pre-existing limitation period (*typically 12 months*), medical records may be requested from the physician or hospital to determine if it is a pre-existing condition as defined in the policy.
- Benefits paid under this policy are paid directly to our insureds to use however they see fit!
